THE EGYPTIAN AND BYZANTINE SPELLING OF λαμβανω IN CLASSICAL GREEK LITERATURE, THE SEPTUAGENT, AND THE NEW TESTAMENT (NESTLE – ALAND TEXT).

THE PROBLEM: TWO DIFFERENT SPELLING CONVENTIONS

The verb λαμβανω has two distinct spelling in four tenses, future middle, future passive, aorist middle and aorist passive. In Classical (Koine) Greek the future middle is spelled ληψομαι, but some Greek authors preferred to spell it as λημψομαι. Note the infixed –μ–. The same infixed –μ– is found in the above four tenses, as well as in some nouns and adjectives. The object of this table was to identify the minority of authors who preferred to use the infixed –μ– form.

Because the future passive and the aorist passive both contain *λημφ* their count was combined under Field 5. Because the future middle and the aorist middle both contain *λημψ* their count was combined under Field 7.

The following four tenses formed the bulk of the evidence, but the count included the moods for each of them.

The data in the following table was compiled from *Thesaurus Linguae Graecae* (TLG) which entered the sources under authors or the titles of works (where the author was unknown). The dates in field 2 and the assigned author numbers (placed in brackets) in field 3 given to each source/author, are those determined by TLG. The count under fields 4-9 consisted of the inflected forms in each grammatical case, and included all prefixed augments to the verb λαμβανω. The actual counts had to be abstracted from the TLG data bank.

- FIELD 1 The numbers represent the chronological order of the authors according to the TLG programme.
- FIELD 2 The dates of the authors are those determined by the TLG programme.
- FIELD 3 TLG has given the Latin spelling for all its sources and authors.
- FIELD 4 MAJORITY TEXT λαμβανω without the infixed –μ–. ληφθησεται, etc. etc.

FIELD 9	EGYPTIAN TEXT λαμβανω with the infixed –μ–. *λημπ* (aorist middle infinitive [λημπτεύεσθαι], imperative [2 pl. λημπτουσασθε]. Another form of the aorist middle infinitive of λαμβανω is λαβέσθαι (see 1 Mac 6:3 et al), etc. etc.
FIELD 10	MAJORITY TEXT: the cumulative totals of fields 4, 6, and 8.
FIELD 11	EGYPTIAN TEXT: the cumulative totals of fields 5, 7, and 9.
